LET'S GET ORGANIZED

Staying organized is important when learning, as it helps you to remember what work you need to do and where your supplies are, but did you know your teacher has to be organized too?

Think about your classroom. What does your teacher use to keep your classroom neat and create a space ready for you to learn? They might use bookshelves, arrange your desks in certain ways, create a comfy, quiet reading corner, or use different containers to hold supplies.

Today you are going to help your teacher keep their desk clean, so they can keep track of their pens and pencils by making a Homemade Pencil Holder.

MATERIALS

- Clean food can
- Paper
- Markers
- Glue
- Scissors
- Various art supplies (Optional)
- Popsicle sticks (Optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

Thoroughly clean the can with soap and water, inside and out, and remove the food label, then dry the can off.

Cut a strip of paper to the height of the can.

Wrap the paper around the can and cut off any extra so that the paper just overlaps a little bit.

If you are using popsicle sticks, glue the sticks side by side to cover the whole strip of paper. If you aren't using popsicle sticks, lay the paper flat and draw on it.

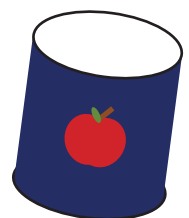
Decorate the popsicle sticks.

Flip the paper over and put glue on the back.

Wrap the paper smoothly around the can.

Press on the outside to make sure it sticks to the can.

Let it dry and deliver your pencil holder to your teacher.
