Brainstorm an art talent to share or draw your favorite types of art below!

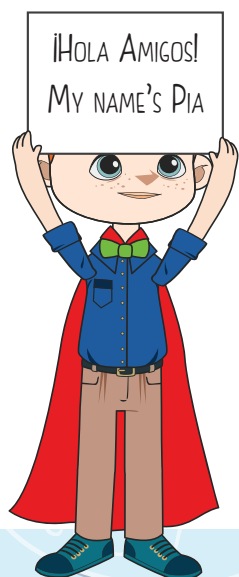
PIA'S GUIDE ON HOW TO MAKE A GOOD VIDEO:

To make a good video, filmmakers first create a plan using a method called storyboarding. Storyboarding is like creating a comic strip; it is a set of drawings with directions detailing what will happen in a movie.

You can use the space on the next page to draw the parts of your video, or you can draw them on bigger paper and ask someone to hold them behind the camera to remind you what to do next, just like a newscaster's cue cards!

MATERIALS

- Video Device
- Cue cards
- Markers

Say hello, welcome the Elder to your video, and tell them your name!

Explain
