REAL-LIFE HUMAN RIGHTS SUPERHERO

After finding a commemorative plaque dedicated to civil rights activist Edwin T. Pratt, 10-year-old Sarah became inspired to make sure more people were aware of his achievements.

To accomplish this, she launched a campaign to have a newly-built learning center in her neighborhood named after Pratt, collecting over 2,000 signatures in support. She succeeded, and the building was named The Edwin T. Pratt Early Learning Center.

Committed to further educating others about Pratt and his legacy, she then started a GoFundMe page which aimed to create a mural depicting the civil rights leader.
