

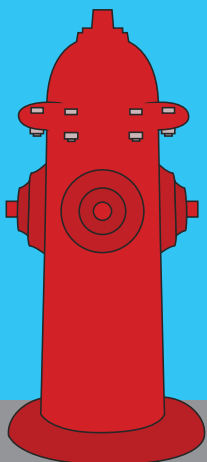


RESCUE BADGE

- Approximately 139 million people visit the emergency department each year.



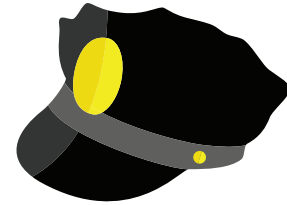
Draw a line to connect the events to the correct rescue worker.
