HONOR COURSE

Memorials are important places for many veterans who visit them to remember their friends and to reflect on the past. But sometimes memorials are far away, and veterans might not have the means to travel to visit them.

An organization called Honor Flights exists to transport these veterans to memorials, and we can help them by raising money.

We can raise money by creating a fun obstacle course, which happens to be an important part of training to become a soldier.

INSTRUCTIONS

Find a long hallway or use pieces of furniture to mimic one.

Attach a length of red yarn to both sides of the wall using tape or pushpins, making sure to stretch the yarn tight.

If you want, attach bells to each length of yarn for added suspense.

Repeat the process down the length of the hallway at different heights and angles to create an obstacle course.

Complete the obstacle course by moving through the yarn lines without touching them. If you touch a yarn/string, you must start over.

Make the obstacle course challenging, but leave enough room so that it is still possible to beat.

Charge people a small fee to attempt the obstacle course, and give out candy prizes to those who complete it successfully.

Donate the money to the Honor Flight Network so a veteran can visit a memorial.

- Red yarn
- Pushpins or Tape
- Timer
- Candy prizes
- Bells (Optional)
